On 11 January, 1917, he wrote to Mrs A Barr (his sister Lizzie) to tell her they had arrived in Folkestone, expecting to be "sailing across the water" the next day and hoped to be home soon safe and sound to my dear old mother, God bless her. He also sent a postcard dated 28 July 1917 saying "I am quite well". He was due to come home on leave around 19 August 1917 with family and friends and neighbours all waiting to greet him.

Instead, the dreaded news, KILLED IN ACTION on 16 August 1917 - sad, sad day.

His name appears on Bonnybridge War Memorial.
